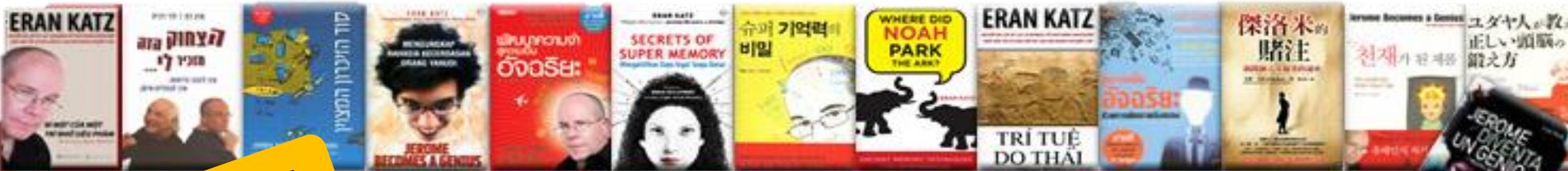
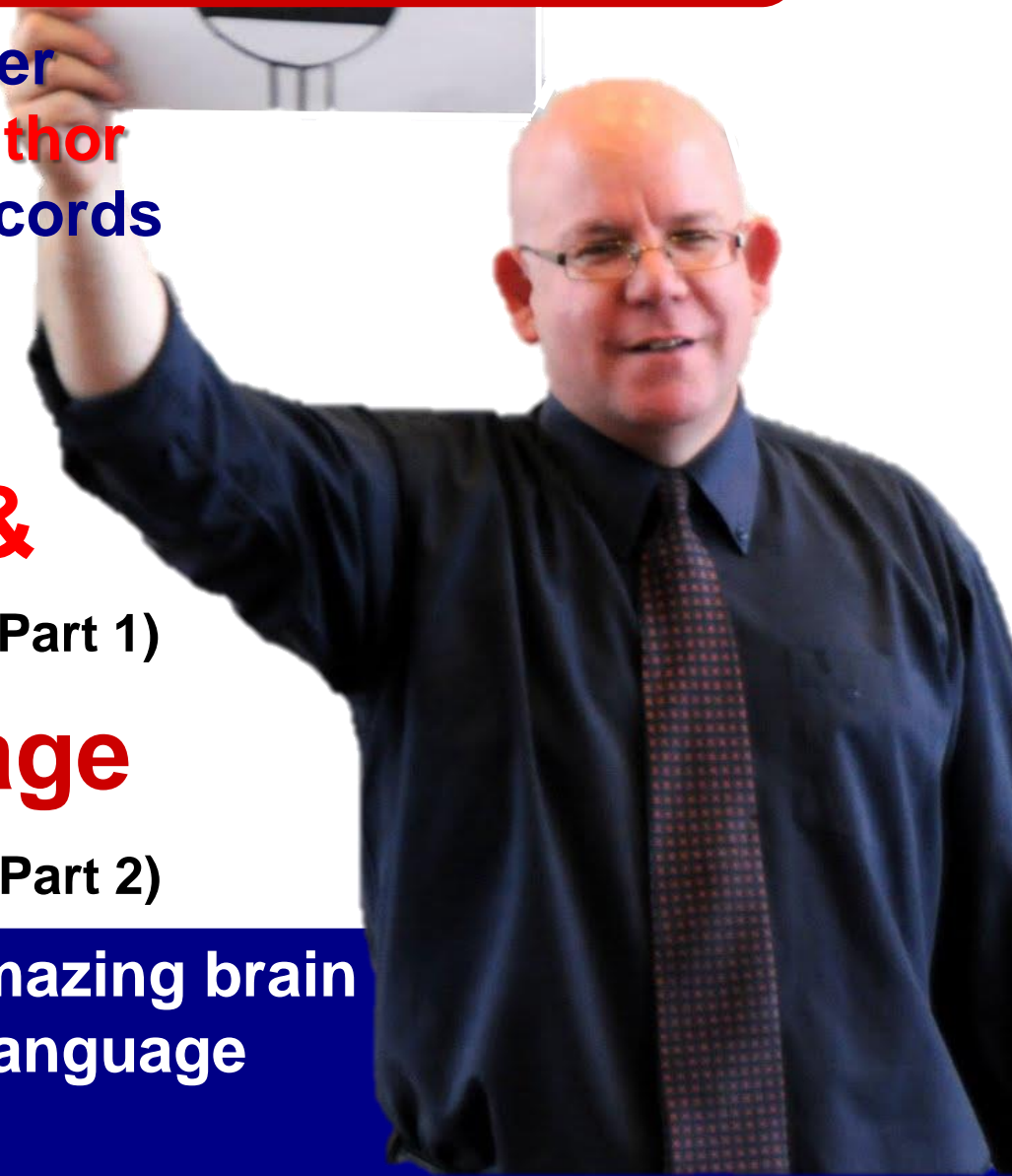

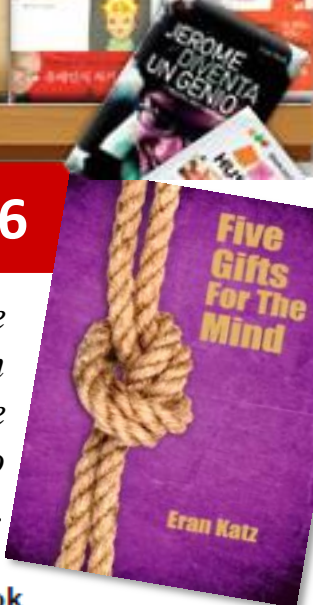

Memory playing tricks with you?

Guinness record holder for best memory, Eran Katz says you can remember 500 digits at a go!

Think of 500 random digits. Write them down. Read them aloud once. Now close your eyes and repeat the numbers. You'll find it's impossible to remember all 500 digits and renowned memory trainer Eran Katz will have you believe so. Visiting India, on behalf of the Consulate of Israel, Katz holds a Guinness record for best memory and has written several bestselling books on memory techniques. Katz also travels across the globe conducting training sessions. "I forget a lot, but I remember what I want to remember. The bottom line is you can do amazing things with your memory. It's a practice, a technique and you have to remember that you can't remember everything," says Katz. Ask him if he had an unfair advantage in school and he says that he would get low grades. "I never wanted to come first, because there's pressure. I'd remember the main ideas. I wouldn't call it copying. It's like cheating, but cheating in a legal way because you use your memory for techniques. What we remember is what really interests us. So if you want to remember something, make it humorous and interesting," he adds. Katz doesn't think he's "blessed" with a gift. The first time he realized he had high retention power was when he was in kindergarten. "My father had to type a code to enter his work area. I saw him type a nine digit code and when he took me three months later, or I told him I wanted to guess the numbers. And I got it right!" But he refuses to be called a genius and credits his ability to motivation more than his memory. He agrees that the techniques he teaches require a certain kind of childlike enthusiasm. "So, your question needs to be 'Why is the sky blue?' and not 'Why didn't you call?' Katz jokes. The expert believes in the motto - the more you remember, the better for you. "It's like going to the gym. Your brain will then become better as you grow older. So people shouldn't be mentally lazy and, say, store numbers on their phones because they don't want to remember them," he laughs. At the moment, Katz is writing a book on impossible things about the brain that are possible to do, such as, erase memory from a language in a month, or fall in love with two people simultaneously? Wonder if he has ever lost at Poker? "I tried Blackjack. But there is only one way to win at a casino and that is to out the casino!" he jokes. And last we tried to remember a list of 30 famous things Katz taught us at his presentation, we scored!

Words of wisdom by 'memory guru' Eran Katz during his seminar

Holding a seminar in Thailand yesterday for the first time on how to improve one's memory, Katz has been invited by the Consulate General of Israel for the celebration of the 60th Independence Day. According to Katz, there are simple and effective techniques that can help you remember things better. "The key to a world with ever-changing information is the ability to filter out what you need. The key is to understand it, to assimilate it, to make it your own and not accumulate it," explains Katz, who calls himself an average person with no phenomenal memory. It's rather easy for the master to recall the names of 20 objects written in a list. So what's the trick? "The trick is to associate the first digit of the list with the first object with another in the list and
